This calendar includes three and a half (3.5) days for staff development and two (2) days for parent conferences. These days and 171 days of student contact days bring the total instructional days to 176.5 days. There are also eight and a half (8.5) grading/work days (2 in August, 6.5 during the year) and five (5) paid holidays, which bring the total number of contract days for teachers to 190.

Inclement weather closures:

Full days lost to inclement weather or other closures will be made up by extending the school year as needed. Missed instructional time due to late starts or early releases because of inclement weather or other emergencies will not be made up unless the fourteen hours allowed by state standards are exceeded.
